<u>City Tree Inventory:</u>

Completed

- All city trees inventoried in boulevard, and mowed areas of Parks.
- Sam handed out data sheet on inventory of trees with all species.
- Total trees (may include some park) 4,100 trees boulevard trees.
- 29% are maple (all species) 7.6% sugar
- Crab apples 6.8%
- White Oak 1.3%
- 35 ash trees left
- Also available planting sites 2018 sites (need to be confirmed).
- 177 critical trees identified.
- Eocene has software we could use \$3,000 but concern is where money will come from.

Federal Grant has been canceled

- Discussion around how to fund software
- Tree pruning RFP canceled

2025 Spring Planting

- 10 trees for Spring
- Arbor Day celebration (Friday April 25).

- Do Earth Day at Fair ground 26th. Need to come up with what we want at table for Earth Day. Sam had brochures printed.
- May order trees from Iowa State Nursery \$1 apiece. 18-24 feet range. These would be paid for by Board Members not City of Decorah and would be given away.
- Ketel will do order (try for 5 species). Sam will get with Ketel for species.
- Hold planting day after fair April 27th Sunday at 1 pm, meet at Street Department and the next Saturday will be rain date.

New Grant: Fall Planting

- Trees Forever Grant.
- 35 from Trees Forever Grant (fall planting) species from Pinters \$5,000 to spend- trees possible River Birch, Cherry, KN coffee, Pagoda dogwood, Gingo, linden, serviceberry.
- Past smaller trees included Blue beech, chokeberry, serviceberry, tree lilac, magnolia, red bud.
- \$5000 max in trees
- Mulch will be in-kind match, plus volunteers, and city equipment.
- Locations 25 in Vennehjem
- 10 to Downing addition

Sam completed Tree City Growth award and Tree City of World award applications. April 3d is recognition. Award are pending at this point.

Sam Status: Still same as last month remain on part-time – only forestry activities - planning plantings, planting, dealing with contractors, neighbor contact.
